

- ◆ CSU-Piat is the first state agricultural college in the province founded in 1954.
- ◆ It is the only state university situated in the Ytawes District of Cagayan.
- ◆ It is a campus which envisions to become an Agri-Eco Tourism site;
- ◆ The College of Agriculture is Level II accredited by the Accrediting Agency of Chartered Colleges and Universities in the Philippines (AACUP) and is working for Center of Development.


